The river was _ _ _ _ _ .

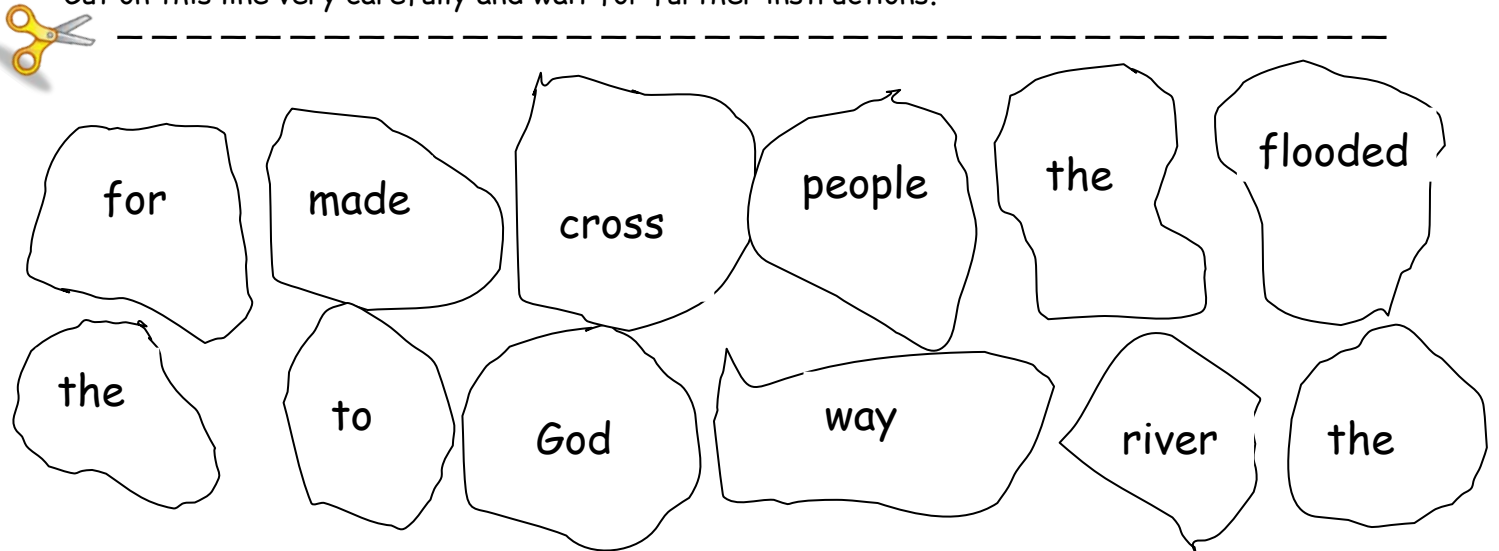
But God knew how to get the people safely to the other side.
