


Jesus is the King.

Read verses 1 to 10. Draw a picture of what happened in verses 6 to 10 in this space.



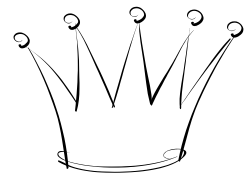
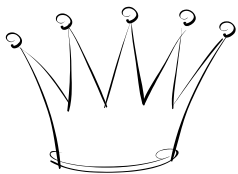
The people shouted praises to Jesus. They said "Hosanna" which means "save now".

In this space finish the sentence explaining why the Baby was to be called Jesus.

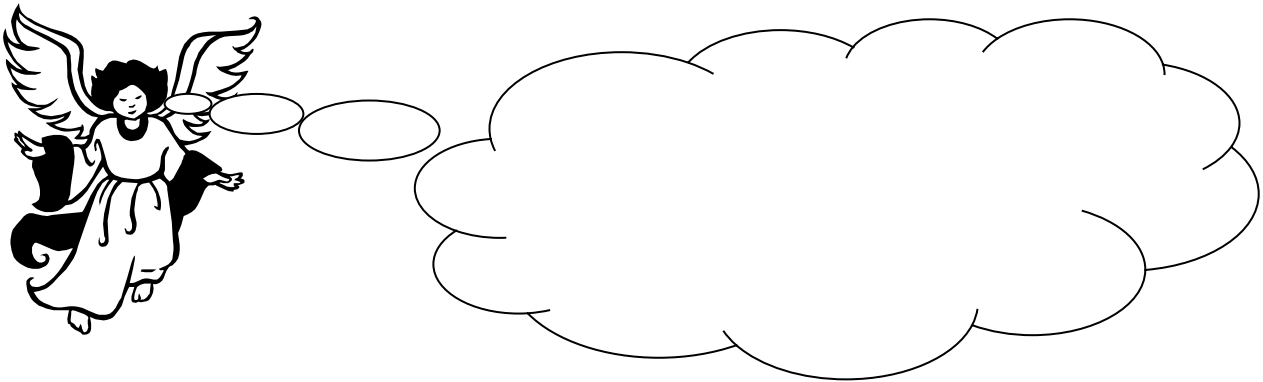


"You will call Him Jesus because

Read some more about when Jesus was born in Luke chapter 2 verses 1 to 16

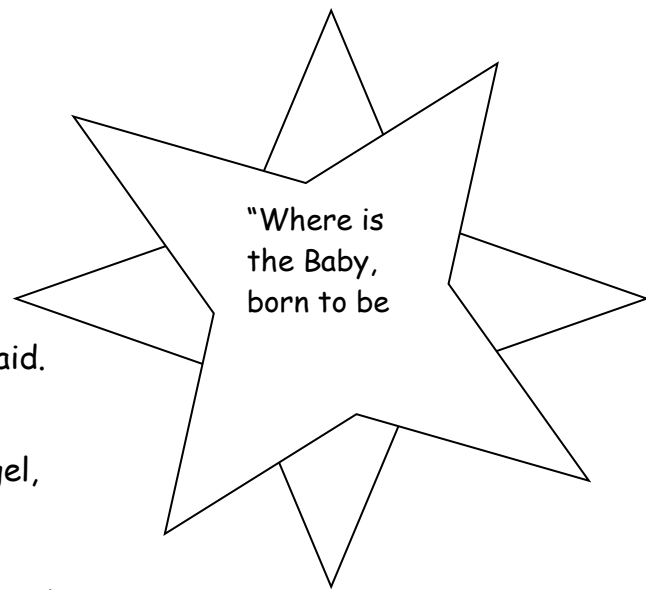
Write what the angel said in verse 11
